**BIG IDEA:** Following Jesus means taking off the old and putting on the new.

#### OPENING QUESTIONS

- 1. If you could restart a year in your life, what year would it be and why?
- 2. One of the best New Year's resolutions I have heard is:

#### IN THE WORD

- 1. Restate Ephesians 4:21-23 in your own words.
- 2. What is the main point in Ephesians 4:21-23?
- 3. Share a way we can be made new in the attitude of our mind, from Ephesians 4:23.
- 4. Philippians 3:12 tells us couple things. First, it tells us that we are not perfect. How can that help us in our new life in Christ? How does Philippians 3:13-14 expand on that idea?
- 5. Second, Philippians 3:12 tells us to "press on" to take hold of Christ. What are some ways we can do that?

#### MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. If taking off the "old self" is like taking off dirty smelly clothes, why is it so hard to do?
- 2. Can you give an example of when you put on the "new clothes" of Christ right over the old "smelly" ones?
- 3. Explain what "think process not perfection" means to you?
- 4. Which one of these three areas do you need to "press on" to take hold of Christ in 2019 and how will you do that?
  - Think future not past.
  - Think God's power not will power.
  - Think process not perfection.
- 5. Pray for one another.
