OPENING QUESTIONS

- 1. In your family, do people tell others what they want for Christmas?
- 2. Can you think of a gift you did not ask for but it turned out to be a good gift?

IN THE WORD

- 1. Read John 3:16. God gave us the gift of Jesus. What is surprising about how Jesus came to earth to people at that time?
- 2. What did you hear in the sermon that surprised you about the town of Nazareth in Luke 1:26?
- 3. Name some of the things we learn about Mary in Luke 1:27-35.
- 4. How is Mary's response to the angel in Luke 1:34-38 different from Zechariah's response in Luke 1:18 regarding the future birth of a child?
- Explain how Ephesians 2:10 fits with understanding God's favor toward us.

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. Mary did not have authority, financial resources, or power, yet she found favor with God to birth His Son. Knowing this, how does this affect your life?
- 2. Give an example from your life of how you found favor with God by asking for help.
- 3. What is something you would like to ask God for this Christmas season?
- 4. How does God's favor and your purpose go together?
