SCRIPTURE: Philippians 2:1-11

- 2. Share something you like about being home at this time.

- 1. What is the author trying to communicate in Philippians 2:1?
- 2. Why is Philippians 2:2 so difficult to do within a family?
- 3. Philippians 2:3-4 talks about impressing others and humility. How can these two go hand in hand rather than competing with each other?
- 4. Why does "thinking of others better than yourself," as stated in Philippians 2:3 help us live more like Christ?
- 5. Name some ways Jesus had the attitude of a servant in Philippians 2:5-7.

- 6. How do you think Jesus kept the bigger picture in mind through the pain of Philippians 2:8?
- 7. In what way can Philippians 2:9-11 give us strength to get through these challenging times?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. Share something you did that was selfish in the past two weeks that affected those you live with.
- 2. While at home, what does it mean for you to grow in humility like Jesus?
- 3. Pick one thing from Bonhoeffer's list that you can work on in April:
 - Hold your tongue.
 - Remember you need God's grace.
 - Forgiving others' mistakes.
 - Consider others' needs as valuable.
 - Listen to others' needs.
 - Speak God's word frequently.
