4. Why does “thinking of others better than yourself,” as stated in [Philippians 2:3](#) help us live more like Christ?
5. Name some ways Jesus had the attitude of a servant in [Philippians 2:5-7](#).

6. How do you think Jesus kept the bigger picture in mind through the pain of [Philippians 2:8](#)?
7. In what way can [Philippians 2:9-11](#) give us strength to get through these challenging times?

2. While at home, what does it mean for you to grow in humility like Jesus?
3. Pick one thing from Bonhoeffer's list that you can work on in April:
