# Jesus Is...: Week 3

## *Jesus is Powerful*

**BIG IDEA:** Jesus is life-changing.

**SCRIPTURE:** John 19:30

### OPENING QUESTIONS

1. Growing up, who did you think was a “powerful” person?
2. My favorite thing about Spring is...

### IN THE WORD

1. What one thing did you take away from the Easter message from [John 19:30](#)?
2. [Romans 5:17](#) makes a contrast between sin and redemption by comparing Adam with Jesus. How can this verse give us both encouragement and challenge?
3. Reading further in Romans, we discover [Romans 6:10](#). Share why this verse is so important especially in times of struggle.
4. Name some ways [Romans 3:23](#) helps us with comparison to others.
5. How can the freedom talked about in [Colossians 2:14](#) help keep us on track in life?

## MAKING IT PERSONAL

1. What does “It is finished” feel like to you?
2. Share a way you have struggled to live in the freedom that Christ gives us through the finished work of the cross.
3. How have you seen comparison be a dangerous thing in Christian’s lives?
4. What does it mean to you to know that “It is finished” and your debt has been paid in full?
5. Who can you talk to this week about what it means to have our sins paid in full? Pray for opportunities to share with someone this week.

## CONTINUED LEARNING

Read [Psalm 22](#). Jesus quoted this Psalm which is a song Jews witnessing His crucifixion would recognize. Notice how this lays out so much of what happens at the crucifixion and ends with the understanding of God satisfying our needs. Think about how they would have felt and how we can rest in knowing this was God’s plan hundreds of years before it happened.
