IN THE WORD

- 1. Since shepherds were unreliable witnesses as mentioned in the sermon, why did the angels first announce the birth of God's Son to them in Luke 2:8-12?
- 2. Explain the significance of the good news in Luke 2:10 being for people in the first century and for us today. How can the birth of this baby 2,000 years ago bring joy to all people?
- 3. What do you think the shepherds' reaction was when the angels appeared to them as referenced in Luke 2:13-14.
- 4. Are the shepherds' responses in Luke 2:15-20 important for us today? If so, why?

MAKING IT PERSONAL

- 1. How does the idea of Jesus the Messiah being for everyone change how you think about people; from those who live next door to people around the world?
- 2. Is there someone you can bring joy to this Christmas?
- 3. What fear stops you from sharing about the Savior of the world with a family member or friend this Christmas?

CONTINUED LEARNING

Read Luke 2:21-38. Notice how two people who waited all their lives were finally able to realize the coming of the Savior of the world. Pray about who in your life has been waiting for their only true Savior.
