¹⁸ Some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a mat and tried to take him into the house to lay him before Jesus. ¹⁹ When they could not find a way to do this because of the crowd, they went up on the roof and lowered him on his mat through the tiles into the middle of the crowd, right in front of Jesus."

• COME FAITHFULLY, DESIRING HEALING.

JESUS:

¹⁷ "...the power of the Lord was with Jesus to heal the sick. (NIV)

READY AND WILLING TO HEAL

"And when Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, 'Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven.'"

Matthew 9:2 (ESV)

THE CONFLICT:

³ "And behold, some of the scribes said to themselves, 'This man is blaspheming.'"

Matthew 9:3 (ESV)

• BLASPHEMY = TO SPEAK OR ACT WITH <u>CONTEMPT</u> OR <u>IRREVERENCE</u> BEFORE GOD.

7 "Why does this fellow talk like that? He's blaspheming! Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

Mark 2:7 (NIV)

o THE PHARISEES WRONGLY ASSUMED JESUS WAS JUST A MAN.

⁴ "But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts?"

Matthew 9:4

(ESV)

• JESUS JUDGES THE PHARISEES/SCRIBES.

⁵ "For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise and walk'?"

Matthew 9:5 (ESV)

• JESUS POSES AN IMPOSSIBLE QUESTION.

⁶ "But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—he then said to the paralytic—'Rise, pick up your bed and go home.'"

Matthew 9:6 (ESV)

• JESUS PROVES HIS <u>AUTHORITY</u> TO DO THE <u>IMPOSSIBLE</u> BY DOING THE IMPOSSIBLE.

THE OUTCOME:

⁷ "And he rose and went home."

Matthew 9:7 (ESV)

- THE PHARISEES DOUBTS AND DISBELIEF WERE <u>DISCREDITED</u>
- THE MAN WAS HEALED TWICE AND RESPONDED WITH OBEDIENCE.

8 "When the crowds saw it, they were afraid, and they glorified God, who had given such authority to men...."

Matthew 9:8 (ESV)

• THE CROWD RESPONDED WITH FEAR AND MISGUIDED WORSHIP.
