

OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECY & NEW TESTAMENT FULFILLMENT OF CRUCIFIXION

GENESIS 3:15 “I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; He shall crush your head, and you shall bruise His heel.”

FULFILLMENT — 1 JOHN 3:8 “He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.”

ZECHARIAH 9:9 “Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, lowly and riding on a donkey, a colt, the foal of a donkey.”

FULFILLMENT — LUKE 19:35–36 “Then they brought him to Jesus. And they threw their own clothes on the colt, and they set Jesus on him. And as He went, many spread their clothes on the road.”

FULFILLMENT — JOHN 12:13 “They took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: ‘Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! The King of Israel!’”

PSALM 41:9 “Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, who ate my bread, has lifted up his heel against me.”

FULFILLMENT — MATTHEW 26:14–15 “Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests and said, ‘What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?’ And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver.”

FULFILLMENT — LUKE 22:47–48 “And while He was still speaking, behold, a multitude; and he who was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them and drew near to Jesus to kiss Him. But Jesus said to him, ‘Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?’”

ZECHARIAH 11:12–13 “So they weighed out for my wages thirty pieces of silver... ‘Throw it to the potter’...”

FULFILLMENT — MATTHEW 26:15 “And said, ‘What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?’ So they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver.”

FULFILLMENT — MATTHEW 27:5–7 “Then he threw down the pieces of silver in the temple and departed, and went and hanged himself... And they consulted together and bought with them the potter’s field, to bury strangers in.”

ISAIAH 53:7 “He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter...”

FULFILLMENT — MATTHEW 27:12 “And while He was being accused by the chief priests and elders, He answered nothing.”

ISAIAH 53:3 “He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief...”

FULFILLMENT — JOHN 19:15 “But they cried out, ‘Away with Him, away with Him! Crucify Him!’”

PSALM 22:16 “They pierced my hands and my feet.”

FULFILLMENT — MARK 15:24 “they nailed his hands and feet to the cross...”

PSALM 22:18

“They divide my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots.”

FULFILLMENT — JOHN 19:23–24

“Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took His garments and made four parts... They said therefore among themselves, ‘Let us not tear it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be.’”

PSALM 69:21

“They also gave me gall for my food, and for my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.”

FULFILLMENT — MATTHEW 27:34

“They gave Him sour wine mingled with gall to drink. But when He had tasted it, He would not drink.”

PSALM 34:20

“He guards all his bones; not one of them is broken.”

FULFILLMENT — JOHN 19:32–33

“Then the soldiers came and broke the legs of the first and of the other who was crucified with Him. But when they came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs.”

ZECHARIAH 12:10

“They will look on Me whom they pierced.”

FULFILLMENT — JOHN 19:34

“But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out.”

PSALM 22:1

“My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?”

FULFILLMENT — MATTHEW 27:46

“And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, ‘Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?’ that is, ‘My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?’”

ISAIAH 53:9

“And they made His grave with the wicked—but with the rich at His death...”

FULFILLMENT — MATTHEW 27:57–60

“Now when evening had come, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph... and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock.”

ISAIAH 53:4–6

“Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows... He was wounded for our transgressions... and by His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all. ”

FULFILLMENT — 2 CORINTHIANS 5:21

“For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.”
