Purpose of Titus

- To instruct Titus about what he should do and teach in the Cretan churches.
 - Titus 1:5 \rightarrow Reason for Titus being in Crete

Themes of Titus

Theme: How the grace of God promotes good works among God's people.

Key verses:

¹¹For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men, ¹²instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age, ¹³looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus, ¹⁴who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds. (Titus 2:11-14, NASB)

⁸This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that those who have believed God will be careful to engage in good deeds. These things are good and profitable for men. (Titus 3:8, NASB)

- What is the "blessed hope" mentioned in 2:13?
