

Community Group Questions:

1. Read Matthew 6:19-20. In what ways does the money we spend, the messages we post on social media, and the pictures on our phones reveal what kingdom we are most invested in? What are some practical ways we can invest in God's kingdom versus our own?

2. Read Matthew 6:22-23. Can you think of examples in the Bible of men and women, or even modern examples who had a single mindedness for the kingdom of God? What habits and disciplines characterized their life?

3. Read Matthew 6:24. Can you think of seasons in your own life when your heart was captivated by another master (i.e. money, popularity, fashion, immorality, success, etc.)?

Going a bit deeper.

The story of the Rich Young Ruler (Mark 10:17-27) is a living illustration of Matthew 6:19-24. How does the love of this world lure the affections of our hearts, cloud the understanding of our minds and, finally, captivate our will? Once you have read the passage, see if you can begin to make the connections. There is more here than you think.
