1. Paul lists over 30 individuals in the final chapter of Romans. We don't know a lot of details about these people but what we do know is that they were "all in" and fully committed to serving the Lord.
 - a. What are some characteristics that demonstrate that these believers gave everything they had in serving Christ?
 - b. What are some factors that keep people back from serving the Lord wholeheartedly?
2. Included in the long list of names were people from all sorts of backgrounds. Some were singles, some were married. Some were parents while others were in the sunset years of life.
 - a. What lessons can we glean from that simple observation?
 - b. How might ministry look different at different stages of life?
3. One of the observations we discovered in the text is that Paul never moved on from the preciousness of the gospel. He continued to draw strength from it, even long past the time he was saved.
 - a. Can you think of ways that the gospel still stirs you and encourages your heart personally?
 - b. What are some ways that the gospel "establishes us" when we are feeling uncertain, confused, or shaken by our circumstances?

Romans 16

Introduction: In Romans 16, we learn some of the most important things we need to know if we want our lives to count for Christ.

- I. Get excited about serving others instead of coasting through life and sitting on the sidelines (vv. 1-2)

- II. Never underestimate the impact you can have regardless of your role or the season of life you are in (vv. 3-16)

- III. Be discerning and don't be lured away by divisive people and false doctrine (vv. 17-20)

- IV. Serve God but never forget that investing in the Lord's work is all about people (vv.21-24)

- V. Never settle into a place spiritually where the gospel no longer stirs you (v. 25)

- VI. Don't ever lose sight of the weightiness of the gospel and the change it can produce in the lives of people (vv. 26-27)
