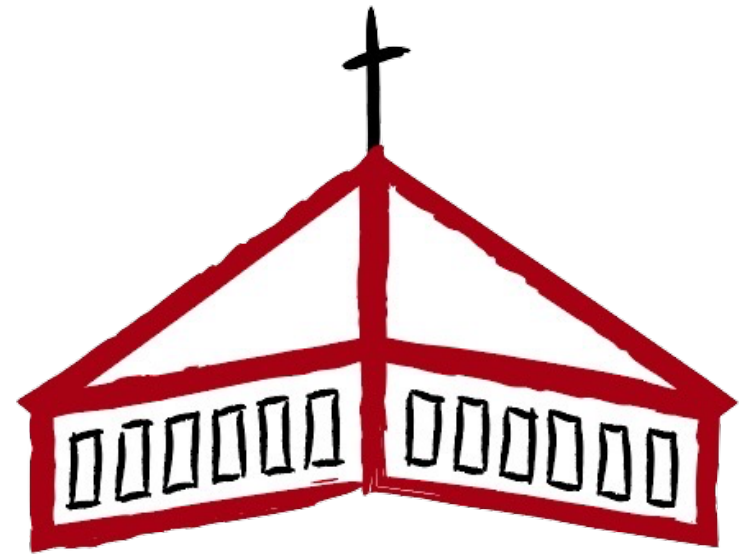


Questions to Think About

Matthew 6:19-24 teaches us to focus on eternal spiritual treasures rather than temporary earthly possessions. Jesus warns that we can't serve both God and money, urging us to prioritize God wholeheartedly and keep our hearts anchored in His kingdom. Questions to consider:

1. In what ways might I be placing too much value on material possessions, and how does that affect my spiritual life?
2. How do I prioritize pursuing treasures in heaven over earthly treasures? What actions reflect this priority?
3. What does it mean to "lay up treasures in heaven," and how can I practically do this in my daily life?
4. How does my heart influence where I focus my energy: on wealth, status, comfort, or service to others?
5. Are there areas in my life where my "eye" might be unhealthy or greedy, impacting my relationship with Christ?
6. How do I respond when confronted with the tension between financial security and spiritual trust in God's provision?
7. What habits or attitudes might hinder me from serving God wholeheartedly, as suggested by the phrase "No one can serve two masters"?
8. In what ways can I ensure that my priorities align with God's kingdom rather than temporary possessions?
9. How does the metaphor of light and darkness in this passage relate to my personal spiritual walk?
10. What steps can I take to cultivate a heart that is focused on God's light rather than material darkness?

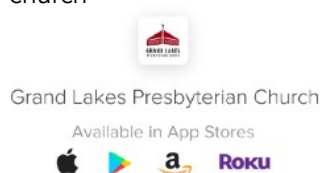


2026 Stewardship Snapshot
