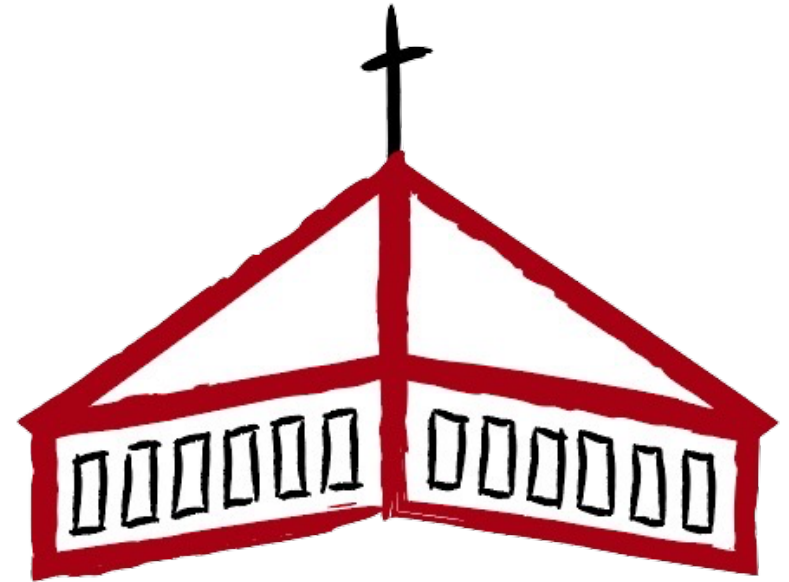

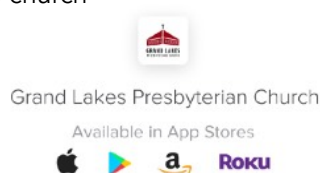


2026 Stewardship Snapshot
