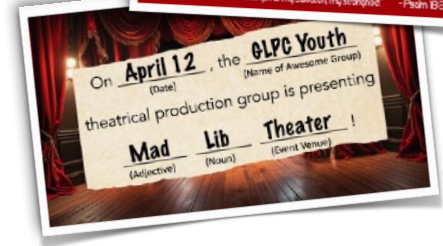
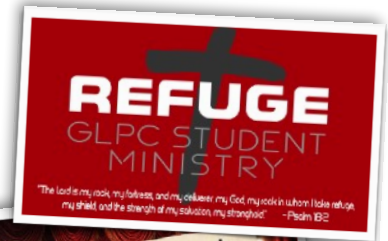
Youth Ministry
