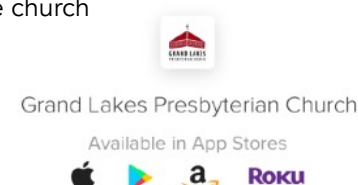
This is a very welcoming group of women of all ages. This group does various studies throughout the year including book and media studies.
