Litany of Penitence

Leader: Your Law is good, and Your judgement is just.

People: We have sinned against You. We have failed to walk in Your ways. We have sought our own glory. We are guilty of iniquity and deserve just punishment.

Leader: You have called us to exemplify Your love and grace and to give of ourselves as You have so freely given of Yourself for us

People: But we selfishly pursue our own gain. We seek to preserve our own well-being rather than promote the well-being of another. We have failed to love you and love our neighbor as you have commanded us.

Leader: We are guilty of sin both as a people and as individuals each one of us. We spend these next moments in silence as we confess to you the ways in which we have personally failed to honor You...
