⁵ Lean on, trust in, *and* be confident in the Lord with all your heart *and* mind and do not rely on your own insight *or* understanding. ⁶ In all your ways know, recognize, *and* acknowledge Him, and He will direct *and* make straight *and* plain your paths.

Trust [rely on and have confidence] in the LORD and do good.⁴ Delight yourself in the LORD, And He will give you the desires *and* petitions of your heart.⁵ Commit your way to the LORD; Trust in Him also and He will do it. ⁷ Be still before the LORD; wait patiently for Him *and* entrust yourself to Him;

1. Trust (have confidence in the Lord)
2. Delight yourself in the Lord. Be glad, rejoice in the Lord.
3. As a result, He will give you the answer to your prayers.
4. Commit or depend on the Lord to give you direction. Have confidence in Him, and He will make it happen.
5. Be still or rest in the Lord. Be at peace while waiting patiently and trusting in the Lord.

Psalms 46:10

"Be still and know (recognize, understand) that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations! I will be exalted in the earth."

1. Be still: stop your mind and emotions from going into worry and fear.

1 Corinthians 15:58

Therefore, my beloved brothers and sisters, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the work of the Lord [always doing your best and doing more than is needed], being *continually* aware that your labor [even to the point of exhaustion] in the Lord is not futile *nor* wasted [it is never without purpose].

1. Be steadfast; be strong, firm
2. Immovable (unmovable): not moved
