#### **Philippians 4:5 (King James Version)**

Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand.

1. The Lord is at hand; the Lord is near; the Lord is coming soon

#### **Matthew 24:37-39 (New International Version)**

<sup>37</sup> As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. <sup>38</sup> For in the days before the flood, people were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day Noah entered the ark; <sup>39</sup> and they knew nothing about what would happen until the flood came and took them all away. That is how it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.

1. The times we live in now are just like before The Flood. It's like it was when Noah was alive.

What did the days of Noah look like?

### **Genesis 6: 1-8 (Amplified Bible Classic Edition)**

When men began to multiply on the face of the land and daughters were born to them,<sup>2</sup> The sons of God saw that the daughters of men were fair, and they took wives of all they desired *and* chose.<sup>3</sup> Then the Lord said, My Spirit shall not forever dwell *and* strive with man, for he also is flesh; but his days shall yet be 120 years.<sup>4</sup> There were giants on the earth in those days—and also afterward—when the sons of God lived with the daughters of men, and they bore children to them. These were the mighty men who were of old, men of renown.<sup>5</sup> The Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination *and* intention of all human thinking was only evil continually.<sup>6</sup> And the Lord regretted that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved at heart.<sup>7</sup> So the Lord said, I will destroy, blot out, *and* wipe away mankind, whom I have created from the face of the ground—not only man, [but] the beasts and the creeping things and the birds of the air—for it grieves Me *and* makes Me regretful that I have made them.<sup>8</sup> But Noah found grace (favor) in the eyes of the Lord.

- 1. The phrase "sons of God" is translated as angels.
- 2. God sent angels down to earth to watch over humans to protect and help them in their fallen state. The ancients knew these angels as watchers.
- 3. These angels took women to themselves and had sexual relations with them.
  - A. These angels disobeyed God by leaving their assignment and defiled themselves.
  - B. These fallen angels taught humans how to disobey God by introducing false beliefs or religion.
- 4. As a result of the relations between the fallen angels and women, giants or the Nephilim were born.
  - A. These giants were huge in size and had great strength.
  - B. They were evil.
  - C. People went about their lives despite Noah warning them of the approaching judgment.

## How do the days of Noah compare to now?

- 1. Some scientists are using technology to create a "superhuman." One of the ways this is happening is by combining human DNA with animal DNA. Its call Transhumanism.
- 2. We are seeing the rise of the occult: the outright worship of Satan and demons, horoscopes, Ouija boards, and witchcraft (manipulation, sorcery, spiritualism, abusing drugs).
- 3. Idolatry (the worship of anyone or anything besides God).
- 4. Murder
- 5. Sexual immorality (sexual intercourse outside of marriage, pornography, swinging (adultery), homosexuality, bisexuality.
- 6. Transgenderism

All of the things listed above are not new. These things we are witnessing now happened back in the days of Noah. Jesus is coming soon! Are you ready?
