3 John 2 (New International Bible)

Dear friend, I pray that you may enjoy good health and that all may go well with you, even **as your soul is getting along well.**

Luke 4:18 (Amplified Bible)

"THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD IS UPON ME (the Messiah), BECAUSE HE HAS ANOINTED ME TO PREACH THE GOOD NEWS TO THE POOR. HE HAS SENT ME TO ANNOUNCE RELEASE (pardon, forgiveness) TO THE CAPTIVES, AND RECOVERY OF SIGHT TO THE BLIND, **TO SET FREE THOSE WHO ARE OPPRESSED (downtrodden, bruised, crushed by tragedy),**

1. Oppressed: brokenhearted; to break in pieces, shattered; crush.
2. **The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, (King James Version)**
3. Is your heart or soul broken?
 - A. From divorce?
 - B. From loss of a loved one?
 - C. From spousal abuse?
 - D. From low self-esteem?
 - a. Self-esteem: how much you value, respect, and like yourself.
 - b. High self-esteem: You accept your flaws, try new things, and bounce back from mistakes without being too hard on yourself.
 - c. Low self-esteem: You doubt your abilities, focus only on your mistakes, and often feel that you are not good enough.

Healing

Isaiah 53:5 (Amplified Bible)

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was crushed for our wickedness [our sin, our injustice, our wrongdoing]; The punishment [required] for our well-being *fell* on Him, **and by His stripes (wounds) we are healed.**

Mark 9:23 (Amplified Bible)

All things are possible for the one who believes *and* trusts [in Me]!"

Mark 11:22-24 (New International Version)

²² "Have faith in God," Jesus answered. ²³ "Truly^[a] I tell you, if anyone says to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' **and does not doubt in their heart but believes that what they say will happen, it will be done for them.** ²⁴ **Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours.**

To be Healed:

1. Study God's Word
 - A. It will renew or transform your mind (Romans 12:2).
2. Believe or have faith in God's Word.
3. Pray in faith (Hebrews 11:6, Mark 9:23, Mark 11:22-24).

A. For everyone born of God is victorious *and* overcomes the world; and this is the victory that has conquered *and* overcome the world—our [continuing, persistent] faith [in Jesus the Son of God]. (1 John 5:4 Amplified Bible)

4. Confess your healing.
 - A. "By his stripes, I am healed from _____ (Isaiah 53:5)
 - B. Confess healing scriptures.
5. Take authority over your issue in the name of Jesus (Luke 10:19)
6. Praise and thank God for already healing you (Mark 11:24)
