Isaiah 59:19 (King James Version)

So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him.

1. Standard: to flee, depart, disappear. Also, a flag of an army used to rally the troops or to declare victory.

What is the Standard?

Colossians 2:15 (New Living Translation)

In this way, he (*Christ*) disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He (*Christ*) shamed them publicly by his victory over them on the cross.

1 Peter 1:3 (New International Version)

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

- 2. Because of the death and resurrection of Jesus, we have the victory over all the schemes of the devil.
