## 1 Corinthians 7:1 (Amplified Bible)

*<sup>11</sup> For the grace of God (His unmerited favor and blessing) has come forward (appeared) for the deliverance from sin and the eternal salvation for all mankind.<sup>12</sup> It has trained us to reject and renounce all ungodliness (irreligion) and worldly (passionate) desires, to live discreet (temperate, self-controlled), upright, devout (spiritually whole) lives in this present world.*

2. Grace teaches us to live right through God's power that lives inside us.
