Of all the things I enjoy about my time at the Free Lutheran Bible College, my favorite part is spending time digging into the Word of God with my classmates. I have always loved learning, but high school was mostly an academic endeavor. Science was my favorite in high school because I got to learn about how detailed and intentional God was when He created the world, even when my textbooks all came from a secular perspective. Now my textbooks are all from an unabashed Christian perspective. My favorite (and most frequently used) textbook is the Bible—the very book that God has written through His people to His people. My favorite classes are the ones that we go straight into the Word of God to see what He has for us. One semester I studied Luke, Acts, and Revelation; the next semester I studied the Pentateuch and Romans. God's Word is powerful (Hebrews 4:12), and through frequent exposure, I have dozens of verses memorized from the year.

Thankfully, classes here are more than just an academic endeavor. They are time that I get to spend growing in the knowledge of my Creator, the one who both designed quantum physics and hand-painted my freckles; my True Love, who came to earth to give His life for mine to save me from sin from which I could not save myself; and my Life-giver, who has graciously bestowed on me my every waking breath, to whom I get to lift my voice and to whom I can return praise.

Recently, Psalm 63 has become a special passage to me. I have been reminded, as the psalmist says, "earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, . . . Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you." I continue to have that delight in spending time in His Word. God is the one who places in me the desire to draw near to Him; He delights in us spending time with Him. I can already see the fruit of how worthwhile it is to spend additional intentional time in the Word. I am glad that learning does not have to stop outside the classroom, but it still does not diminish my gratitude for being able to spend time in classes.
