- 3. "Set your mind" v. 2 is literally "have this inner disposition"
 Heaven is contrasted with "things on earth." What are heavenly values?
 What are values of the world system? Please give examples.
- 4. In vv. 3 and 4, there is a contrast between "hidden" and "revealed". Who are "hidden" in v.3? Who are revealed in v. 4?

 How do verses 3 and 4 encourage you? (see I Cor. 2:14; I John 3:1)
- 5. "Christ, who is our life..." v. 4 (See Gal. 2:20; Phil. 1:21). In what ways does your life demonstrate Jesus Christ? What are particular challenges that work against this demonstration of Christ?
