How precious is your steadfast love, O God! The children of mankind take refuge in the shadows of your wings. Psalm 36:7

This verse consists of two lines that praise God for His faithful care and kindness to those who trust in Him. The first line includes a Hebrew word that is so full of meaning it is hard to translate as just one word into English. It is the Hebrew word *chasid*, which includes the idea of love, faithfulness, mercy, kindness, or loyalty. It especially describes the LORD's relationship with those whom He has made covenant with. He sacrifices even Himself in order to be faithful to those whom He loves and has made promises to. That certainly is a precious thing for His people. It has value above all other things. As Paul writes, "Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord" (Philippians 3:8). To know God is to be known by Him, to be known by Him is to be loved. How amazingly precious it is to have His steadfast love! For it gives us eternal life.

The second line gives us an illustration of His faithfulness and kindness to us. It uses the image of a mother bird stretching out her wings to protect her babies. She puts her wings out to provide a safe place, a refuge, for her family. In doing this, the mother bird puts herself in between the chicks and whatever is threatening them. This is a fitting image to show us how God gives Himself to provide a safe place for us. He puts Himself in the way of judgment for sin, so that we can find refuge under His cross. He has taken that judgment on Himself, so that we can draw near to Him. That is faithfulness. That is lovingkindness and mercy and steadfast love for us. And He is faithful to continue to protect us in this life. When trouble comes, take refuge under His wings, for He loves and cares for you and has provided a refuge that you can flee to.
