“A Man Who Lost His Coat, Not His Character”- Gen. 39:6-23

1. In vv. 2, 3, 21, 23, What do we learn about Joseph and his relationship to the Lord?
2. How is Joseph’s relationship to the Lord a key to understanding his refusal to commit sexual sin?
3. In vv. 6b-10, we read of Joseph’s refusal. Can you think of any “excuses” Joseph might have used to justify being with Mrs. Potiphar?
4. What impresses you about Joseph’s speech (vv. 8, 9)?
5. To Whom was this “great evil” directed, or, rather, it would be sin against Whom (v. 9)?
6. From a human perspective, was Joseph “successful”?
