The Love of God

After our worship one Sunday, one of my faithful parishioners made an honest request: would I permit him, during the service, to suggest a song to be sung by the congregation if it fit well with the message being preached? I was curious to find out what tunes he might propose. One he especially liked was “The Love of God” by F. M. Lehman (*Ambassador Hymnal* #201), particularly the third stanza:

*Could we with ink the ocean fill,
And were the skies of parchment made,
Were every stalk on earth a quill,
And ev’ry man a scribe by trade,
To write the love of God above
Would drain the ocean dry.
Nor could the scroll contain the whole,
Though stretched from sky to sky.*

*O love of God, how rich and pure!
How measureless and strong!
It shall for evermore endure
The saints’ and angels’ song.*

What greater description of the unsurpassing love of our Savior has ever been penned than that? I gladly gave my permission to make such a request!

We live in a society starving for love but at a total loss to know how to identify it. Evangelical scholar D. A. Carson has suggested that “the love of God in our culture has been purged of anything the culture finds uncomfortable. The love of God has been sanitized, democratized, and above all sentimentalized.”

People all around us need to see and grasp and experience God’s great saving love. They need to witness it being lived out by God’s people. *We* need to see it on display in our homes and in our congregations. Scripture calls us to this: “Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another” (1 John 4:7–11 ESV).

Friends, that is love’s portrait, which “*shall for evermore endure, the saints’ and angels’ song.*” Those who know it are called to show it. *Thank the Lord for His amazing love for you today!*
