

LIFE GROUPS—Week of Jan. 25, 2025 (Study 15)

“Life More Abundant” (Colossians 3:15-17)

1. The abundant life means that the peace of God rules in our hearts (v.15). The word “rules” in the Greek means “to referee” or “to umpire.” How does this help us to understand the “rule” of peace in our hearts?
2. Do you have peace in your heart? (See Romans 5:1)
3. Is there a difference between “peace with God” and the “peace of God” (see Phil. 4:7).
4. What does the Word of Christ give you in v. 16?
What does wisdom do?
5. Singing is a mark of the ministry of the Holy Spirit, a sign of the indwelling Word. In the last 2000 years, whenever the Word of God is prominent, it is received with great joy which is expressed in song. Revival times have been times of great singing! When the Word of God dwells richly in you, you want to sing with thankfulness in your heart! (No matter your voice!)
6. In v. 17 “word” or “deed” takes in everything in life. Everything we say or do is to be done “in the name of the Lord Jesus.”
7. Note the references to “thankfulness” in vv. 15-17. Why is this so very important?
