Ice Breaker: Since the beginning of our Lent series, *Journey to Jerusalem*, in what ways has Jesus challenged, confronted, or stretched an area of your life that needed to be addressed?

1. Read Luke 10:38-42 together as a group. What are your first impressions about Mary and Martha when you read this passage?
2. Who are you more similar to, Mary or Martha? Give some examples or illustrations.
3. According to the passage, the point isn't to choose whether Mary or Martha, or what they're doing versus what they're not doing is better or worse, rather the emphasis is on priority. Why do you think priority of worship and spending time with Jesus is so important?
4. When you honestly reflect on your current life situation, have you been running without refueling, serving without being filled, or doing without first *being*? What are the consequences of a life lived this way?
5. What is one practical next step you can take this week to prioritize Jesus in the midst of all the current events, the to-do's and busyness of life?



This Lent, we challenge you to FAST from anything you depend on more than God so you can grab hold of Jesus more fully. As we begin *Journey to Jerusalem*, we invite you to move beyond listening and into active participation. Each week, trail markers in the lobby will feature a QR code pointing you toward guided responses that include Scripture, reflection questions, fasting challenges, and prayer walks, drawing you deeper into a lived pilgrimage toward the cross and resurrection.
