


## SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

**Series:** Prophecy for a New Day Haggai I

Part 1 – Prophecy & Priorities Pastor Tom Kang

- I) What are the first things that come to your mind when you hear "Prophecy for a New Day" or the word "prophecy" in general? How would you define "prophecy" and the "prophetic"? What has your experience been up to now with prophecy?

- 3) Jews were held captive in Babylon for 70 years (607-586 BC) ... and though not nearly as long ... still more than ever before, we also have experienced a small taste of "captivity" in the last fifteen months from this global pandemic. Discuss what kind of excitement, anticipations and concerns you have today as you prepare to "emerge out of captivity" with others around you.
- 4) Read together Haggai I, aloud. What are the observations that stick out to you the most and why?
- 5) Haggai goes through great lengths to compare the people's work and investment on their own homes vs. the work and investment on House of the Lord. How does this strike you? What might God be saying here through his prophet, to His people?
- 6) Is God your #I priority? Share. Why or why not?
- 7) Do you believe you are one of God's priorities? (Haggai 1:13) And how does your life reflect or not reflect this conviction?
