

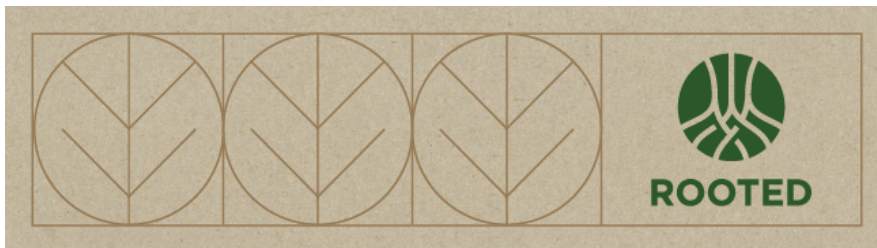
AN UNSTOPPABLE FORCE

(Acts 8:26-39)

- 1) Who are the people that have helped you become who you are today (spiritually)?
- 2) Read **Acts 8:26-40**.
 - a) What was significant about the Ethiopian eunuch Philip encountered on the desert road? Why was that significant?
 - b) Why did the Ethiopian invite Philip to join him in his chariot?
 - c) What examples of the Holy Spirit's leading do you see in this story? How has the Holy Spirit been leading you lately? Where and how is God at work in your life?
 - d) Think about the eunuch's immediate baptism (vv 36-38). Why is baptism an appropriate response to belief? If you were baptized, share what prompted you to get baptized. If not, what's preventing you from being baptized?
- 3) **Motorboat vs. Sailboat**: What are the differences between the two? Which one describes your life lately? How is partnering with God like sailing a boat?
- 4) Pastor Stephen shared that in order to partner with God to fulfill His divine purpose here on earth, we need to **a) Listen to the Holy Spirit, b) Embrace the misfits, c) Share the Good News**. Which out of the three is God prompting you to pursue more? What action steps do you need to take to make it happen?
- 5) Who are the Ethiopian eunuchs in your life that God is compelling you to reach out to?
- 6) Pray for God to provide "divine appointments" for you like He did for the Ethiopian and Philip. Pray that you would be sensitive to the leading of the Spirit in coming days and weeks.
