Part 2: Blessed are the Meek

- 1) Share one lesson you heard in your pre-collegiate years that made no sense then ... but now, years later, makes all the sense in the world.
- 2) Why do you suppose the quality of meekness is considered such a weakness today? Where do you see examples of this misconception in your life and around the world right now?
- 3) Read Psalm 37 aloud as a group. Did you notice the portion Jesus paraphrased in his most popular sermon (Mt 5)? What other portions of this psalm stick out to you and why?
- 4) How do the two examples of meekness from this Sunday (and the consequent displays of mercy and healing that resulted from them) challenge you?
- 5) How would a true assessment of yourself (Mt 5:3-4) lead you to be “meek” – to have a humble and gentle attitude toward others (v5)?
- 6) Why is it surprising from the earth’s point of view, that the meek will inherit the earth? What does it mean to “inherit the earth” and how does that apply today?
