Icebreaker: What is one “epic moment” or defining moment in your life that you still remember clearly, and why does it stand out?

1. Read Joshua 3:5-17. Joshua told the people to consecrate themselves before God acted (v 5). How might consecration prepare us to receive God’s work? What do you think it looks like practically to “set yourself apart” for God in this season of your life?
2. The ark of the covenant went ahead of the people as a sign of God’s presence (v 6). Why is following God’s presence more important than having our perfect plan? In what areas of your life do you most need the reminder that God is already ahead of you?
3. The priests had to step into the Jordan before the water parted. Why do you think God often asks for obedience before He reveals the outcome?
4. The text notes the Jordan River was at flood stage (v 15). What does that teach about God’s timing and power in the face of real obstacles?
5. Pastor Stephen emphasized that fear can keep us from experiencing God’s divine moments. What fear tends to hold you back most often, and how has it affected your decisions?
6. What is one specific step of faith you believe God may be asking you to take this week, and what would it look like to act on it even if you still feel afraid?
