Series: The Father's Heart Part 3 — Unity through Reconciliation and Justice Pastor Raymond Chang

- I) What stood out from the message? What impacted you?
- 2) Pastor Raymond said that justice, reconciliation, and unity are intertwined throughout the book of Ephesians. To get to unity, we need to pursue reconciliation, but to pursue reconciliation, we need to be committed to justice. Is this something you considered before? If so, in what ways? If not, what does that mean for you moving forward?
- 3) Christians love unity, but as we heard in the message, unity reveals the strength of the unifying force. What do the worldly divisions within the church communicate to you about the unifying power of the gospel? What does it communicate to you about what the church (at large) actually believes about Jesus?
- 4) Jesus calls us into the ministry of reconciliation in 2 Cor. 5:18. Is there anyone you need to reconcile with? What will you do to move towards reconciliation?
- 5) Jesus calls us towards justice based on his justice. In what ways do you think you are called to pursue justice in your life?
- 6) What are you going to do differently as a result of what you heard this week?
