- 1) Ice breaker: What is one cooking ingredient that you cannot live without?
- 2) The key ingredient for discipleship is the church. We cannot grow in our faith journeys without it. But sometimes we misunderstand what the church is. The church isn't a building or a service, it's God's people described locally or globally. Why does having a proper definition for the church matter?
- 3) Acts 2:42-47 describes the early church. Read through this passage and share the kinds of values you see in the church. Which value do you want to help foster at NewStory?
- 4) In Sunday's message, Pastor Dustin described three essential relationships for discipleship – relationships with leaders, peers, and disciples. All of these relationships are necessary for the church to grow in love and good deeds. How well-developed are these relationships in your life? Are there any steps you need to take to grow in this regard?
- 5) One of the powerful statements Scripture makes in Matthew 16:18 is that the church will not be overcome. No matter what opposition there may be to God's people, they will continue to stand strong. Knowing this, spend time praying for strength and growth in one another.
