Part 7: Reunion

1. Go around the group and share the first thoughts that come up when you hear the word “surrender.” Are these thoughts generally positive or negative?
2. Biblical surrender can be defined as “the willingness to entrust one’s life into God’s hands.” How do you see this surrender in Jesus’ life? And do you see any glimpses of this in Jesus’ words in Luke 23:46?
3. Jesus’ prayer in Luke 23:46 is a reference to Psalm 31:5. In other words, Jesus prayed Scripture. What are your experiences with using the Bible to guide your prayers? If you found it helpful, explain why. Lastly, will you commit to praying Scripture this week?
4. Jesus was willing to commit his spirit to God because he saw Him as a trustworthy Father. Do you see God in these ways? What are the ways you doubt God’s trustworthiness? What are the ways in which you have experienced it?
5. If you haven’t yet surrendered your life to God, what’s holding you back? If you have, what else is God convicting you to entrust to His care in this season?
6. If group members have already or want to surrender their lives to God and haven’t yet been baptized, there is a special opportunity to do so. Pray over these individuals and have them sign up for baptism at newstorychurch.com/easter!
