Part 10 – Together in Unity Pastor David Kim

- 1) Psalm 133 is a Psalm that speaks of unity. Sounds simple enough! But what are some things that may potentially divide us even in the church?
- 2) Read Psalm 133. What stands out to you from this passage?
- 3) Why do you think unity is so important? Why does God care so much about it? Another way to think about it is, what are the ramifications and consequences of division?
- 4) According to verses 2 and 3, there are two benefits and blessings that flow out of our unity: anointing and refreshment. What does anointing and refreshment look like in our context today and how can this be an encouragement to seek unity.
- 5) Practical Application:
 - a. What can you do this week to seek unity with someone you disagree and differ with? Keep each other accountable so that the people of God could reap the blessings that flow out of know people in your own life that need this sort of restoration?
 - b. In light of Asian hatred crimes and tragedies taking place in our nation, share how this is affecting you and spend time together to pray for healing and wisdom on showing solidarity against racism as a Christian community.
