Icebreaker – Identify something that you haven't yet finished. What would it take for you to complete it? Describe something you've finished or accomplished. How did you feel when you completed it?

- 1) Read John 19:28-30.
 - a) What was Jesus referring to when He shouted, "It is finished"?
 - b) What is the difference between saying "I am finished" and "It is finished"?
 - c) Why do you think it mattered to Jesus to make this statement on the cross?
 - d) Why do you think this is absolutely vital to our faith as Christians?
- 2) On what basis is Jesus' final word on the cross to be understood as a cry of victory? How does that and could that impact the everyday life for a believer?
- 3) Practically speaking, what does it look like to trust in the finished work of Jesus Christ?
- 4) In what area of your life do you need to declare Jesus' victory today? After sharing, read Romans 8:31-39.
- 5) Who are some people God has placed in your life to invite to Easter this year? Spend some time identifying and praying for them together.
