- 1) Which testimony from the missions teams stood out to you? Why?
- 2) For those who have been on global missions, what is your own story? How did God move during your missions experience?
- 3) Read John 20:21.
 - a) Jesus repeatedly told his disciples “Peace be with you” three times in John 20 (v. 19, 21, 26). Why do you think he emphasized that?
 - b) What is the relationship between Shalom and the Great Commission?
 - c) Why do you think Jesus told his disciples “Peace be with you” before sending them into the world?
 - d) “As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you.” How did the Father send the Son? How does that answer determine how we accomplish the mission of Jesus?
- 4) Every Christian is a missionary, sent into the world to be intentionally engaged in the mission of God both locally and globally. What is the mission field God has called you to? How can you bring the peace of God into that space?
