Part 4: Purity & Peace

ICEBREAKER: One of the concepts we are focused on this week is “PURITY.” What areas of your life do you desire this elusive quality and why?

- 1) Share your thoughts on the following quote and its relationship to The Beatitudes so far (Matthew 5:1-9):
“If I find in myself a desire which no experience in this world can satisfy, the most probable explanation is that I was made for another world.” -C.S. Lewis, *Mere Christianity*
- 2) What role do PRIORITIES play when it comes to PURITY? How do you see Psalm 51 relevant in this discussion? What role does PERSISTENCE play when it comes to PURITY?
- 3) Read Psalm 139 together and share the elements most notable to you. Also discuss what God’s omnipresence means for you today and what is its relationship to having a “pure heart” and growing in spiritual maturity.
- 4) Discuss the connection you see in Matthew 5:9 and Colossians 1:19-20. Also discuss what the difference is between a keeper of peace and a peacemaker?
- 5) Where is The Spirit of God leading you to “make peace” (not just keep it) this week? Share your convictions and pray for one another, that God’s Spirit would work mightily toward this endeavor.
