- 1) How was success defined in your home growing up?

  - a. What do you know about Naaman and his character in this passage?
  - b. Who does God use in Naaman's spiritual story, and what role does each person play in pointing Naaman to God?
  - c. Sometimes we come to God expecting one thing, and He gives us another. What did Naaman expect Elisha to do for him? How did God's plan differ?
  - d. What does Naaman's response in verse 15 say about his spiritual condition?
  - e. How does Naaman's story point you to the gospel?
- 3) Instead of looking for God, Naaman was just looking for a cure for his leprosy. What are you prone to look for from God instead of knowing Him? Why?
- 4) As you read Naaman's story, reflect on your own spiritual story. What weakness has God given you to reveal your need for him?
- 5) Who has God put in your life to point you to Jesus?
- 6) What areas of your life do you need to surrender to God? Spend time praying for one another.
