**Icebreaker:** Who would you say is the most proud and/or most humble person you know?

I) Read and discuss the following quotes. Is there one that challenges you more than any of the others?

"[Pride] is the most hidden, secret, and deceitful of all sins." (Jonathan Edwards, Advice to Young Converts)

"Unchastity, anger, greed, drunkenness and all that, are mere fleabites in comparison: it was through Pride that the devil became the devil: Pride leads to every other vice: it is the complete anti-God state of mind." (C.S. Lewis, Mere Christianity)

"It was pride that changed angels into devils; it is humility that makes men as angels." (St. Augustine)

- 2) The following three problems of pride were identified. Which one do you resonate with the most and why?

  - 2) Pride destroys \_\_\_\_\_\_ . (*Proverbs 13:10*)
  - 3) Pride produces \_\_\_\_\_\_\_. (1 Peter 5:6-7)
