


## **SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS**

Title: Seeing 2020 Pastor Richard Lee

- 1) What are some things you don't understand about 2020?
- 2) Have you ever had an experience where you suffered and didn't gain perspective on it until many years later or are still waiting? Share it with your group.
- 3) READ Luke 2:39-40. When Jesus was born, He was born into the world that was not expecting Him and definitely didn't notice Him. No one noticed that everything changed. In fact, people had to wait 30 years before Jesus began His earthly ministry to reveal Himself. God chooses to change everything, but He does it in such a way that no one notices. When we are faced with something that we don't understand, what should be our response? (cf. Romans 8:24-25).
- 4) Sometimes it's hard to not rush God. What is something you heard in the message that gives you comfort in waiting?
- 5) How will "looking to God" change the way we approach 2021?
- 6) What area of your life do you need to look to God? And not to rush him? Share and pray together.
