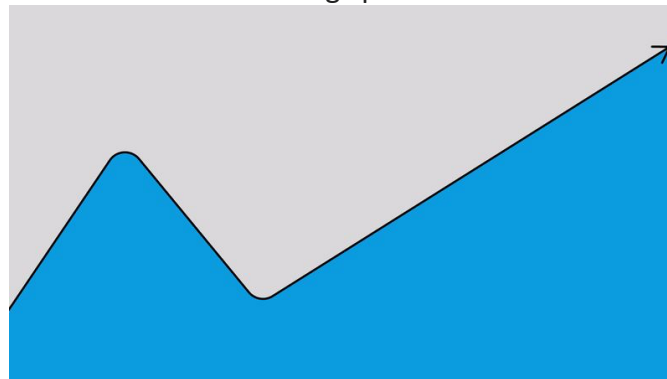




## Part 3 – Worship

**Icebreaker:** Think of something you started on a high - new job, relationship, health kick, even your faith - that later dropped into 'The Dip.' What did you tell yourself at the bottom? Did you push through? What did the "line ascending" part look like?



1. In Chapter 3, Habakkuk stops asking "Why?" and starts reciting God's past faithfulness (splitting the sea, Sinai, etc.). What are some of the "Greatest Hits" of God's faithfulness in your own life that you need to remind yourself of right now or in seasons of "How Long"?
2. Read Habakkuk 3:16-19 together as a group (slowly and read twice if time allows). This is Habakkuk's WORSHIP through chattering teeth and fear... What is a "fig, vine, or olive" in your life that you're counting on? That maybe you're even idolizing?
3. Reflecting on Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego's declaration ("But even if he does not..."), what does a "but even if" faith look like for you now and in the future?
4. "Jesus may save you from the fire OR He will stay in the fire with you." How does this truth move you to worship and say "yet I will rejoice..."?  
Fill in the blank and share: "Though \_\_\_\_\_ may (or may not) happen... YET I will rejoice in the Lord."
5. Habakkuk started by screaming "How long, LORD?" but ends up singing "though the fig tree does not blossom ... YET I WILL REJOICE in the LORD". Share prayer requests on how you can continue to trust and obey God always but especially in the seasons of How Long...
