

## **SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS**

Part 4: Evangelism Pastor Dustin Lang

- 1) Ice Breaker What is a decision you made as a child that you regretted later on?
- 2) Every day we are faced with decisions. Decisions of what to wear, what to eat, who to see, and how to spend our time. For Christians, there is another decision we make: will we share the gospel or not? Go around the group and honestly share your thoughts on evangelism (i.e. fears, insecurities, joys, excitement, struggles, etc.).
- 3) Romans 10 gives a strong challenge to the church to proclaim the gospel. Read verses 13 and 14 and discuss whether it's enough to embody Jesus in our actions without telling others about Him.
- 4) The Samaritan woman's decision to share Jesus with others led to the result we see in John 4:39. Read that verse together.
- 5) Your decision to evangelize can lead to the same outcome. Practice sharing your 1-minute faith story and the Roman Roads gospel presentation in groups of 2 or 3 using the following prompts:

## **Faith Story**

- 1. Before Christ What was your life before knowing Jesus?
- 2. Conversion What led you to accept Jesus as Lord and Savior?
- 3. After Christ How has Jesus changed your life?

## **Gospel Presentation (Romans Road)**

1. Everyone has sinned

Romans 3:23: "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

2. The price of sin is death

Romans 6:23: "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

3. Jesus paid the price for our sins with his death

Romans 5:8: "But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

4. We receive salvation through faith in Jesus

Romans 10:9: "Because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."
