- 1) How are we doing with the points (below ;-)) from the first message of Haggai, chapter one? Share an example of how one of the points impacted you in a practical way over the past few days.
 - #1) *Carefully consider PRIORITIES, especially during transitions.*
 - #2) *Make sure God & the things of God are your FIRST priority.*
 - #3) *YOU are a priority for God. (He is with you.)*

- 2) As the world around us begins to “REOPEN” ... what are some honest thoughts and emotions you are experiencing? Where do you see signs of either change or transition in work, school, community and relationships? How does God’s Word help you there?

- 3) After reviewing the first 3min of the Haggai summary video (see below) and considering some of the supportive/parallel Haggai 2:1-9 passages (namely Ezra 5:1,2; Isaiah 9,60,62; Micah 4,5; Zechariah, Malachi) ... discuss why you think the Temple was so important to the Israelites back then AND what does that mean for you, today?

- 4) Read Haggai 2:1-9 aloud. Next identify and discuss the prophet’s message specifically regarding the Past, Present & Future (3 main points from this week’s message). What strikes you the most about each?

- 5) Which of the 3 dynamics above (Past, Present, Future) as addressed by Haggai, typically proves most challenging for you? Spend some time sharing your reasons why. Finally, pray for one another, specifically, with regard to those areas.
