1) Read Genesis 12:1-9 as a group. What is the most shocking thing about this passage for you? What stands out to you?

2) Why do you think it's so hard to hear God and follow His leading for us? Hint: Scripture uses the word "faith" to describe this phenomenon.

3) The reality is we all exhibit faith in our daily lives. Can you explain some areas of your life where you exhibit faith?

4) By and large we exercise faith in people, but why do you think it's so difficult to exercise faith in God? And what does that tell us about our relationship with God?

5) They say that Christian life is a journey and Abraham's life was a life of pilgrimage. He never really settled anywhere. He wandered through Canaan for the entirety of his life. What is the difference between a traveler and a pilgrim? And what does that have to do with the Christian experience?

6) What can you do today or this week that will help you hear the voice of God in your life? And what next steps can you take to trust God more fully?
