Part 4 – The Legacy We Leave

- I) What comes to your mind when you think of the word "legacy?" If there are specific individuals or groups that you think of, feel free to mention who they are and the legacies they left. Make sure to also include some negative examples.
- 2) Zechariah warns the Israelites to learn from the mistakes of their fathers in Zechariah 1:1-4. Read through this passage and describe the legacy that was left by the generation before them. If this group were living today, what would their lives look like?
- 3) How is God leading you to learn from the mistakes of those before you?
- 4) The way to leave a spiritual legacy is by living obediently to God's Word. Read through Zechariah 7:8-10 and share one of God's commands that you want to live out.
- 5) The first portion (chapters I through 8) of Zechariah ends with a beautiful picture of the spiritual legacy God would leave through His people. Read Zechariah 8:11-13. Share how you would like to be a "blessing" to those around you. Then, end your time by praying in response to what is shared.
- Though small group is over, your time with God can continue on throughout the week. We encourage you to read through Zechariah I to 8 before Sunday so you can dive deeper into God's Word this week.
