SUNDAY RECAP

We continued in our series, **Consecrated Living**, focusing on what it means to live consecrated lives, specifically in the area of power and influence. Before starting the questions with your group, invite God to reveal Himself through His Word and by His Spirit during your discussion.

KEY PASSAGE: Mark 10:42-44

"Jesus called them together and said, "You know that those who are regarded as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

OPTIONAL ICEBREAKERS

Share about a time someone gave you a chance, opportunity, or voice you wouldn't have had otherwise.

DISCUSSION GUIDE

- 1. What's something from the passage or this week's message that resonated with you?
- 2. What does Jesus' teaching about leadership ("not so with you") tell us about how power is viewed in the Kingdom of God? How does Mark 10:45 summarize Jesus' entire mission?
- 3. What are some modern examples of people "lording it over" others? How does Jesus' model contrast with that?
- 4. Consider Jesus' path of power from the list below. Which one do you personally find to be the most challenging or disruptive?
 - -Weakness (willingness to suffer rather than to dominate)
 - -Sacrificial love
 - -Servanthood
 - -Humility (hiddenness)
 - -Worship
 - -Lament
 - -Repentance
- 5. In your own context (work, family, church, community), what kinds of power or position do you have? How are you tempted to use your influence for personal advantage rather than service?

30 DAYS OF CONSECRATION

As part of this series, we invite you to participate with us as we set apart time to connect with Jesus. Each week, there is a Scripture to meditate on, daily prayer, and weekly practice as an act of worship.

This week the invitation is to serve someone who has less power or influence than you. Below are some ideas to try this week. Discuss with your group something you could try to help you grow.

- Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you if there is anyone you need to apologize to
- Smile and say "hello" to someone you see regularly but never acknowledge
- Do a task "beneath" your position
- Choose to defer to someone else in a decision you'd normally make
