#### **RFCAP**

We continued in our **Rooted in Love** series in Ephesians 4 this weekend. Before starting the discussion questions with your group, pray together and invite the Holy Spirit to be present with you as you study through this passage.

ICEBREAKER: What is your favorite Halloween candy? What kind can you absolutely not eat?

### DISCUSS

- 1. In this passage, Paul emphasizes the importance of oneness, unity and maturity in the Church. What part of the message or this passage convicts you and why?
- 2. In the message, we learned that in order to obtain unity in Christ, we need to seek oneness in His Church. How can we do that at Fair Oaks?
- 3. How has the Church been there for you?
- 4. What is your role when it comes to seeking oneness, finding service, and welcoming the outsider as part of our Fair Oaks Church family?
- 5. Discuss your understanding of our unified church mission and vision. How can we focus on and prioritize this in the coming season together?

KEY PASSAGE: Ephesians 4:1-16
MEMORY VERSE: Ephesians 4:2-6
