

DIGGING DEEPER

Week 6 | Ephesians 4:17-32





RECAP

We continued in our *Rooted in Love* series in Ephesians this weekend. Before starting the discussion questions with your group, pray together and invite the Holy Spirit to be present with you as you study through this passage.

ICEBREAKER: What was something you loved when you were younger that you no longer like (food, candy, movie, hobby, etc)? What changed?

DISCUSS

- 1. Look again at verses 22-24. Paul is calling the people of God to be "made new" and live transformed lives. Reflect back on the last year of your life. What change or areas of transformation have you seen in your own attitudes, thoughts and actions? How has the Holy Spirit been transforming you?
- 2. Paul describes the "old self" and the "new self" in verses 25-32. As a group, go through Paul's list. Which is the most challenging or convicting for you?
- 3. When it comes to anger and how we handle it, how can we resolve it in a quicker and healthier way, instead of letting it fester and turn to bitterness, grudges and resentment? What has helped you in your life and relationships to practice this?

SCRIPTURE

KEY PASSAGE: Ephesians 4:17-32 MEMORY VERSE: Ephesians 4:32

Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

- 4. Revisit verse 30. Is "grieving the Holy Spirit" something that you've considered before? Share with your group.
- 5. One of the most powerful parts of this passage is verse 32. Paul frames us forgiving others through the lens of Christ forgiving us. How does this impact you?

Share prayer requests and pray together as a group. Please especially pray for Pastor Garrett's family and our church as we mourn this loss together.
